

Ariel Paz-Sawicki is a doctoral candidate (supervisor: Prof. Lior Herman) at the Hebrew University. His research focuses on the political economy of natural resources and energy markets. In particular, he is focused on the Israeli energy sector, and the dynamics between various stakeholders (corporate; governmental and civil society), as well as regional actors. Ariel's main research method is quantitative text analysis, creating structured textual databases from unstructured sources such as government documents, protocols, media etc., and applying statistical and NLP tools to derive insights on his research topics. Apart from his academic work, Ariel is head of research in the public advocacy organization Lobby99, which works to promote the public interest within the Israeli government on issues of energy and natural resources.
