

Lior Elbaz is an Associate Professor for Electrocatalysis and Sustainable Energy in the Department of Chemistry, Bar-Ilan University, Israel. He is the head of the Israeli Fuel Cells Consortium (IFCC), composed of 17 leading Israeli labs, the Israeli representative to the International Energy Agency's Advanced Fuel Cells Executive Committee, a member of the Israeli Presidential Climate Forum, and was recently appointed as the director of the hydrogen technologies center (H2Tech) in the framework of the National Institute for

Sustainable Energy (NISE). He is the co-Founder of two Israeli start-up companies, developing reversible fuel cells and fuel cells for stationary power supply.
